

Lesson Plan Guidelines Visual Arts

- All instructors are required to submit a lesson plan. **Lesson plans are due Monday April 9th.**
- It's better to over plan! Be sure to have enough projects to fill time and to keep campers engaged and excited about art!
- All art projects for Visual Arts need to relate to the session description for the week.

Lesson Plan Cover Page:

- Include Week #, Dates of Session, Session Theme, and Teacher Name.
- Main Lessons: Create 3 to 4 Main Lessons to facilitate each day.
- Quick Lesson: This is your go to project that's less involved and can fill time.
- Self-Directed Lesson: This is a project that campers can work on independently throughout the week. When campers finish their Main Lessons early, direct them to work on this project.
 - Example: Sketchbook Drawing: direct campers to draw something relating to the camp session description in their sketch books.

Lesson Plans:

For each project, please be sure to include the following:

- Project Title: Name the project to be facilitated and include a photo of the project to be completed.
- Project Steps: Include the necessary steps needed to complete the project. Please be clear and concise with your step by step instructions.
- Regular Supplies: Refer to the Visual Arts Cart Inventory Sheet for a list of "Regular Supplies" to be used for projects.
- Extra Supplies: Refer to the Extra Supplies Available list for all "Extra Supplies" to be used in projects.

Please refer to the sample lesson plan included for further explanation.

Visual Arts Projects CAN Include Some of the Following:

- **Clay Project**: Using air dry clay, campers will sculpt an object relating to the camp topic.
Supplies: air dry clay, tempera paint, paint brushes, paint trays, mod podge, and clay tools
- **Collage Project**: Campers will create a colorful image relating to the camp topic.
Supplies: construction paper, tissue paper, newspaper or magazines, scissors, glue, black sharpies
- **Drawing Project**: Campers will draw people, places and/or things relating to the camp topic.
Supplies: pencils, colored pencils, oil pastels, colored markers, black sharpies, crayons, black construction paper, drawing paper
- **Painting Project**: Campers will paint people, places and/or things relating to the camp topic.
Supplies: brushes, paint trays, watercolor paint, or tempera paint
- **Printmaking Project**: Campers will choose a person, place or thing relating to the camp topic. Using a pencil, campers will create a simple line drawing on scratch foam.
Supplies: pencils, scratch foam, brayers, ink, foam trays, and construction paper.
- **Sculpture Project**: Campers will create a 3D non clay sculpture relating to the camp topic.
Supplies: newspaper, paper mache paste, balloons, soup cans, egg crates, toilet paper rolls, paper bowls, bucket.

SUPPLIES:

- All Visual Arts camp instructors shall use the supplies listed on the “Visual Arts Cart Inventory” AND the “Extra Camp Supplies” forms for their art projects throughout the week.
- **No budget is available for ordering any specialty supplies not listed or included on those forms.**
- When listing the supplies needed for each project, please be specific and clear about what you need. Include the amount, size, and color of your supplies.
 - **EXAMPLES:** Yarn: red, 12 inches per camper
Fabric: Purple, cotton, 1 yard per camper
Styrofoam Balls: 15 at 2 inches
Watercolor Paper: 15 pieces cut to 5x7
Tissue Paper: 5 sheets each of red, green, and yellow
Construction Paper: 15 sheets of orange
Printmaking Ink: Purple, Red, and Turquoise

Visual Arts Camp (Ages 7-10)

Exciting hands-on activities allow campers to explore art, meet creative challenges, and exercise their imaginations. Campers will broaden their creativity through drawing, painting, sculpture, printmaking, and many other artistic mediums.

Creative Explorations: *5/30-6/2

Join this journey of creativity, exploration and discovery! Campers will explore a variety of projects that incorporate creative ideas and art concepts utilizing various mediums and techniques. Expand your horizons in this fun and thoughtful week as you express yourself both independently and creatively.

Art in Nature: 6/5-6/9

Get inspired by nature! Campers will enjoy hands-on activities and time to create individual and collaborative art. Come celebrate nature and create your very own nature inspired masterpieces!

Cartoons, Comics, & Figures: 6/12-6/16

Bring your favorite cartoon and super hero characters to life! Campers will learn how to draw emotion, action and background scenes as they create their personal comic book. Enjoy a fun filled week of design, drawing, printmaking, and sculpting.

Art and Stories: 6/19-6/23

Bring magical stories to life through art! Campers will explore painting, drawing, printmaking, and collage as they create art projects using stories, poems, songs and their imagination. Join us for a fun and creative week of adventure, tall tales and art!

Mixed Media Mania: 6/26-6/30

Mix it up! Join the fun of experimenting with and combining drawing, painting, collage, and printmaking to create unique mixed media art projects. Campers will utilize a variety of materials and learn new methods and techniques for creating art.

Invent, Design, Create!: *7/3-7/7

Let your imagination run wild as you invent, design, and create your own DIY art projects. Explore, construct, and collaborate freely utilizing an assortment of materials to engineer amazing pieces of work. Embrace your inner maker as you tinker with creative ideas.

Modern Art Exploration: 7/10-7/14

Discover the world of modern art. Campers will explore both abstract art and conceptual art as they exercise their imaginations. Creative art projects including collage, sculpture, multi-media, drawing and painting, that will challenge and inspire.

Painting Possibilities: 7/17-7/21

Explore the colorful wonderful world of paint. Build painting skills and learn the basics of value, perspective, and color mixing. Campers will learn about various artists and discover unique ways to apply paint on different surfaces.

Zen-Doodle Adventure: 7/24-7/28

Learn how to doodle with a purpose. Campers will experiment with patterned drawings to create personal one of a kind art projects using pens, markers, watercolor, and colored pencils.

Summer Sampler: 7/31-8/4

Try a little bit of this, that, and the other! Campers will experiment with an assortment of art materials to create an exciting collection of unique masterpieces.
