





Students will look at examples of pop art and talk about ways to reproduce an image over and over...with printmaking. 2. We will draw our own prehistoric creature or person on paper, then transfer them to scratch foam using pencils. 3. Using various colored inks and brayers students will make single and double colored prints on paper. 4. Have students look at images of different types of butterflies and insects and their patterns. 2. Students will sketch out shape on black construction paper. 3. The design on the inside of the wing will be cut out 4. The background paper will be painted with watercolor. 5. <p>Watercolor Dinos</p> 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Student will first look at images of real dinos. 2. Next they will draw the outline of their dino adding any patterns or details(spots, stripes, tongue catching a fly, etc.) 3. Students will use oil pastels to outline their dino, then begin painting with watercolor. 4. <p>Coil Clay Snails</p> 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Students will learn the technique of rolling and creating a coil. 2. Once students have learned how to create a coil, they will learn about “scratching and attaching”, to attach coil to itself and to attach coil to the body of the snail. 3. <p>Foil Plants/Fossils</p> 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Students will look at images of fossils, petrified leaves and so forth. 2. Students will plan out their design on poster board using pencil. 3. Once their fossil design is completed they will outline it in glue, letting it dry overnight. 4. The next day we will cover the design in tinfoil, attaching it to the back with tape and using an eraser to push down tinfoil in detail areas. 5.
