

Lesson Plan Guidelines
Studio Arts Camp

All instructors are required to submit a lesson plan. **Lesson plans are due on Monday, April 8th.**

Lesson Plan Cover Page:

It's better to over plan! Be sure to have enough projects to fill time and to keep campers engaged and excited about art!

- Include Week #, Dates of Session, Session Name, and Teacher Name
- **Main Lessons:** Create 3 to 4 Main Lessons to facilitate each day.
- **Quick Lesson:** This is your go to project that's less involved and can fill time.
- **Self-Directed Lesson:** This is a project that campers can work on independently throughout the week. When campers finish their Main Lessons early, direct them to work on this project.

Lesson Plans:

For each project, please be sure to include the following:

- **Project Title:** Name the project to be facilitated and include a photo of the project to be completed.
- **Project Steps:** Include the necessary steps needed to complete the project. Please be clear and concise with your step by step instructions.
- **Regular Supplies:** Refer to the "Visual Arts Cart Inventory" and the "Studio Arts Inventory" for a list of General Supplies available for use with camp projects.
- **Extra Supplies:** Refer to "Extra Camp Supplies" for a list of all Extra Supplies available for use with camp projects.
- **Supplies to be Ordered:**
 - Please do your best to utilize the General Supplies and Extra Supplies Spruill has available and on hand for your Specialty Camp projects.
 - **Studio Arts Camps have an assigned supply budget of \$15 per student for a total of \$225.00.**
 - When listing the supplies needed for each project, please be specific and clear about what you need. Include the amount, size, and color of your supplies.
 - **EXAMPLES:** Yarn: red, 12 in. per camper
Fabric: Purple, cotton, 1 yard per camper
Styrofoam Balls: 15 at 2 inches
Watercolor Paper: 15 pieces cut to 5x7
Tissue Paper: 5 sheets each of red, green, and yellow
Construction Paper: 15 sheets of orange
Printmaking Ink: Purple, Red, and Turquoise
 - General Camp Supplies will be ordered from Blick Art Supply and/or Binders Art. Please look at these websites first when placing a request for purchasing Specialty supplies:

 - **To request Specialty Supplies for purchase, please create an itemized supply list (see example included). List each item individually, provide the item # or SKU, include the cost and the website url for ordering purposes.**
- **EXAMPLE:**
 - Environmental Technology Casting Resin Catalyst 1oz
 - SKU 033331463619
 - \$7.50

- **All Specialty supplies will be ordered by the Camp Director unless discussed otherwise.**
