Summer Camp Art Instructor

Spruill Center for the Arts seeks creative, enthusiastic, and kid-friendly teaching artists, art instructors, and/or college/graduate students studying Visual Arts or Arts Education to teach and provide enrichment activities for our week-long art camps June 1 – August 6, 2021.

Campers ages 5-6 (Creative Arts) and 7-10 (Visual Arts) will be learning about various artists, art history, styles and techniques. The art instructor will create a lesson plan based on the week's theme using a variety of mediums.

Hours are Monday – Friday (with the exception of Memorial Day and 4th of July holiday week), 9am-4pm. Instructors are required to work the full week of camp. Applicants are subject to a background check for criminal and child protective findings.

Responsibilities include:

- Work cooperatively with administration and camp staff
- Supervise youth by planning and implementing activities
- Engage campers and encourage creativity
- Create lesson plans
- Attend camp meetings
- Abide by the organizational policies, procedures, and perform other duties as assigned.

Qualifications:

- Experience as a teaching artist or art teacher
- Visual Arts or Arts Education Graduate or Undergraduate (who has completed student teaching requirements)
- Experience working with youth
