SUMMER CAMP

Performing Arts Summer Camp Instructor

Center for the Arts seeks creative, enthusiastic, and kid-friendly teaching actors, theater instructors, and/or college/graduate students studying theater arts, drama, or performing arts to teach and provide enrichment activities for our week-long art camps June 1 – August 6, 2021.

Campers (ages 7-10) will be learning the art of acting, improvisation, song, dance, and stage direction. The performing arts instructor will need to create a lesson plan based on the week's theme. Each week will conclude with a live performance.

Hours are Monday – Friday (with the exception of Memorial Day and 4th of July holiday week), 9am-4pm. Instructors are required to work the full week of camp. Applicants are subject to a background check for criminal and child protective findings.

Responsibilities include:

- Work cooperatively with administration and camp staff
- Supervise youth by planning and implementing activities
- Engage campers and encourage creativity
- Work with campers to create characters, costumes, props and set design
- Create a lesson plan based on the week's theme
- Attend camp meetings
- Abide by the organizational policies, procedures, and perform other duties as assigned.

Qualifications:

- Experience as a teaching artist or art teacher
- Theater Arts Graduate or Undergraduate (who has completed student teaching requirements)
- Experience working with youth
