


# WELCOME TO THE SPRUILL CENTER




We are excited to welcome students into the our space starting January 2024!

What's more, the pathway from the back of the library parking lot to the building will now be a paved ramp (no more stairs!) making it easier to bring a rolling cart of supplies into the building.





# CREATIVE DRAWING: EXPLORE THE POSSIBILITIES OF GRAPHITE, CHARCOAL, AND INK NEW!

Instruments used might be pencils, Neo Color Crayons, pens with inks, brushes with paints, or any combination,
